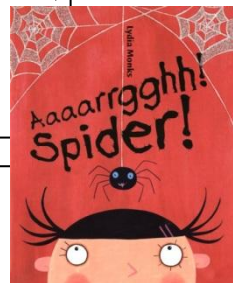

Science: Animals

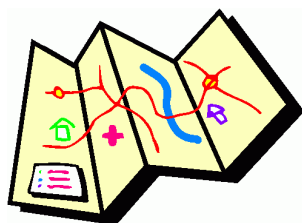
Sort animals into insects, fish, amphibians, reptiles, birds and mammals using venn diagrams and sorting trees.

Have a Teddy bears picnic.



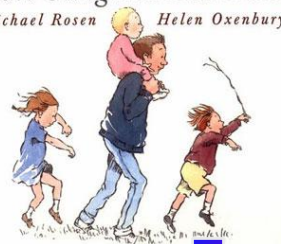
Geography/History

Mathematics

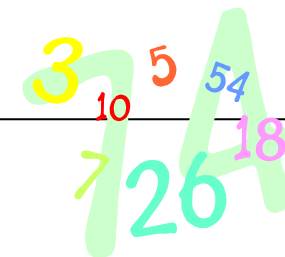
Read, write and order numbers to 20 and beyond without reversing the numbers.
