Fractions of numbers. Finding equivalent fractions and simplifying fractions.

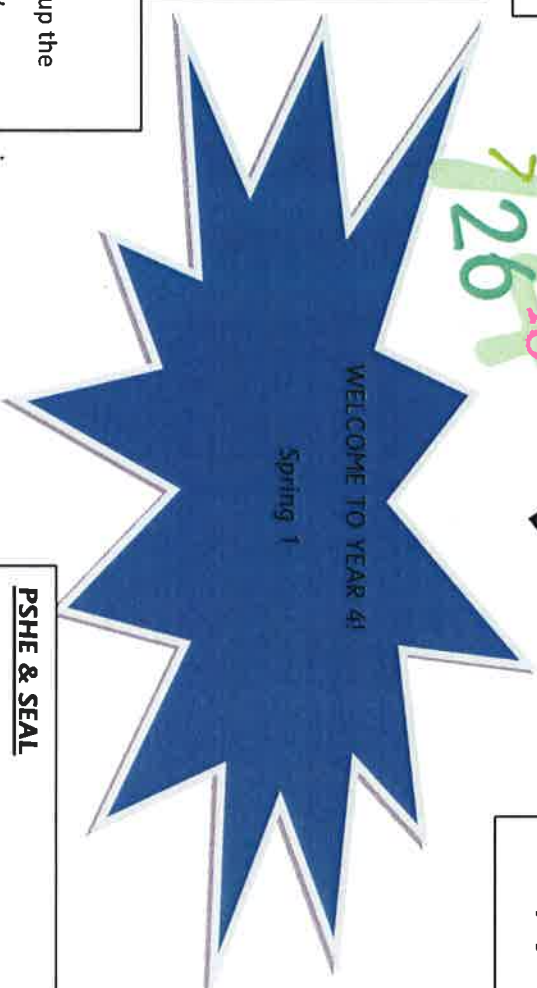
Vocabulary of angles and recognising acute and obtuse angles. Perpendicular and parallel lines. Identifying lines of symmetry.

Geography: United Kingdom and Llandudno

We will be finding out about the rivers, mountains and capital cities, of these countries, and also identifying some famous landmarks. We will be developing our skills with maps and atlases, during this topic and using an 8 point compass to describe positions. Later, we will study in detail a contrasting locality in the U.K., i.e. Llandudno.
