Literacy:

Narrative writing:

We will be reading and writing traditional tales and adventure stories. We will be focusing on sentence structures during writing and will be developing comprehension skills and reading stamina.

Non –Fiction:

We will be focusing on information texts and the children will be creating their own information text about the Romans using Computing skills.

How can you help at home: please read daily with your child and return their **signed** reading records **each day**. Encourage and support your child with homework tasks.



Art/Design and Technology:

Topic: We will be focusing on the artwork of one of our class authors/illustrators Colin Thompson.

Skill: The use of colour and shade to create effective images. Looking at the use of pencil to create an image.

This term we will be focusing on multiplication and division, addition, subtraction, fractions and place value. We will also be applying the 4 main operations (addition, subtraction multiplication and division) to problem solving.
