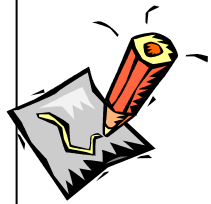


### Literacy

### Computing

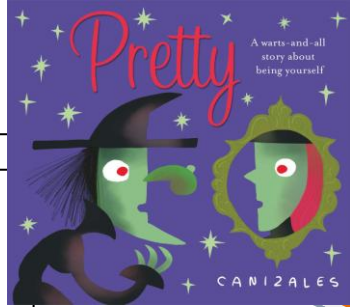
The first unit will be Key Skills.

### Numeracy

Count in steps of 2, 3, 5 and 10, forwards and backwards to 100.  
Locate 2 digit numbers using number line and a hundred square. Read  
and writes numbers to 100 in numerals and words.  
Find 10 more and 10 less than any number up to 100.  
Solve problems involving addition and subtraction.  
Each week, children will take part in an 'arithmetic session, working on exam style questions.

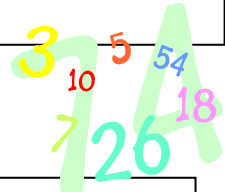
### D&T
