

Literacy

Our class novel will be The Angel of Nitshill Road by Anne Fine. First, we will be writing our own wishing tale based on The King of the Birds. Later on in the term, we will take notes from the Tutankhamun video and rewrite Howard Carter's diary entry on the day the tomb was opened. We will study information texts and write a page for an information book about Ancient Egypt. We will be practising our handwriting and spelling. We will bring home spelling words each week. We will read in a group each week, and can earn stickers and prizes if we get our reading diary signed.



Science

We will be describing the simple functions of the digestive system in humans.

We will identify the different types of teeth in humans and their functions.

We will learn to classify living things and construct a variety of food chains.

Numeracy – We will be learning to:


Understand place value and use this to order and compare numbers.
