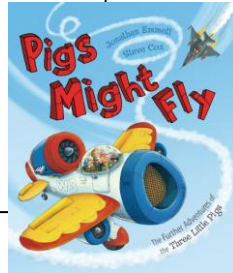
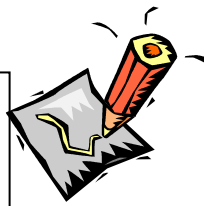
Plan and write a story using Pigs Might Fly by Jonathan Emmett

Tell and write the time to 5 minute intervals

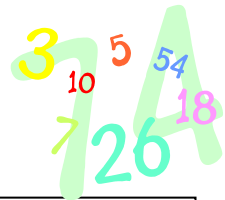
Interpret and construct pictograms, tally charts, block diagrams and simple tables
