

### Literacy

We are continuing our work on newspaper reports, writing a report about Good Friday and also about Easter Sunday. In grammar, we will continue to practise direct and indirect speech.

Then, we will be learning the story of the Pied Piper of Hamelin. Then, we will be changing parts of the story to write our own version.

We will continue to practise our spelling, grammar and handwriting.

In reading, the skills we will be developing, will be matching and inferring. We will continue to extend our vocabulary.

### Computing

We will be using the Ipads and iMovie to retell a story or event using moving images.

### Numeracy

We will be learning to convert between measures of length and mass. We will re-visit converting analogue to digital time and 12hr clock to 24hr clock. There will be further practise of calculating perimeters. Regular opportunities will be given to reason and solve word problems and practise written calculations.

We will continue to use Learning by questions to support our learning, and will practise our times tables regularly, in order to ensure we know ALL our times tables and divisions by the end of the year.

### Science

We will be studying animals and their habitats. We will find out about life cycles of plants and mammals. The life of Jane Goodall and her work with chimpanzees will be studied.

### History- Anglo Saxons

We will be learning about why the Romans left Britain. We will be discovering what life was like for Anglo Saxons and how converting to Christianity changed their lives. Evidence from Sutton Hoo will be studied to help us understand how these people lived.
