

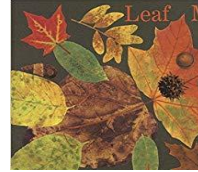

Mathematics

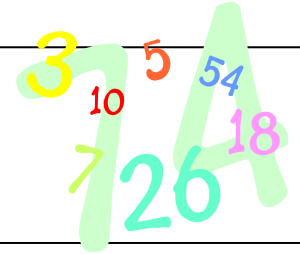
Read, write and order numbers to 20 and beyond without reversing the numbers.

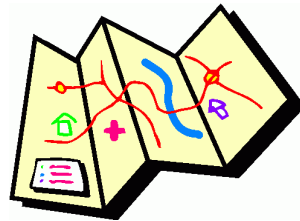
Science: Animals including humans

Describe the different features that animals have e.g. tail, hooves, claws, snout and antennae.

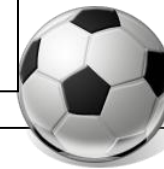
Talk about differences between humans and animals.
