Numeracy – We will be learning to:

Identify where 4 digit numbers are positioned on a number line, rounding them to the nearest 10, 100 and 1000.

Vocabulary of angles and recognising acute and obtuse angles. Perpendicular and parallel lines. Identifying lines of symmetry.
