Literacy:



Handwriting will be a big focus in Year 3 as we move towards cursive handwriting.


We will have focus grammar lessons to develop use of punctuation and to develop sentence structure.

Narrative writing: we will be focusing on sentence structure, use of adjectives and adverbs.

Non-Chronological Reports: we will be learning how to read, understand, resent and write a non-chronological resport.

How you can help at home: reading regularly boosts both your Childs reading and writing.

In reading we will be focusing on finding information from the text to answer who, what, where, when, why and how questions in fiction and non-fiction.



Science:

Rocks! – We will be learning about what the world in like underneath our feet and how fossils are formed and found.

Forces and Magnets! – What is a push and a pull? How do magnets work?



Homework:

All homework will be set online using Seesaw. Your child has abrought home a letter explaining how to access their work and their login details. Homework will be set each Friday to be completed by the following Friday. Times Table Rockstars is also a great resource to support rapid recall of multiplication facts.

Numeracy:



This term we will be focusing on Place value, addition and subtraction, multiplication and division.

We will be learning about the value the digits and how to partition 2 and 3 digit numbers. We will learn how to use column addition and column subtraction to add and subtract larger amounts.

We will also cover the Year 2 topics of Fractions and Time.

We will be elarning to read the time on an analogue clock to 5 minute intervals and to calculate time differences.

We will develop our understanding of fractions to find fractions of shapes and amounts.

How you can help at home: regular Times Table practise is extremely important. Completing online homework will help to develop your child's understanding.
