

## English

We will be practising our handwriting and spelling every day, using different games and activities.

For spelling, we will be concentrating on adding suffixes.

In grammar – we will be revising capital letters, full stops, question marks and word classes, such as nouns, verbs, adjectives and adverbs. We will also be learning how to use alphabetical order to quickly look words up in a dictionary or thesaurus.

There will be plenty of opportunities to show what we have learned in our own writing.



## Reading

We will be reading “The Angel of Nitshill Road” by Anne Fine in our whole class story session. In our reading lessons, we will be doing some group reading and whole class reading lessons. The first book we are all going to share is “Mufaro’s Beautiful Daughters” by John Steptoe

## Numeracy – We will be learning to:

Understand place value and use this to order and compare numbers.

To round numbers to the nearest 10,100 and 1000.

Add and subtract numbers with up to 4 digits.

To count back through zero using negative numbers.

To read and write Roman numerals to 100.

We will also be visiting some of the Year 3 objectives, which the children missed, starting with finding the perimeter of shapes.

**We will be encouraging the children to learn and practise their times tables.**

## Science

We will be describing the simple functions of the digestive system in humans.

We will identify the different types of teeth in humans and their functions.

We will learn to classify living things and construct a variety of food chains.

## Music

Mrs Lindop will be coming in to teach us the ukulele on a Thursday.

## PE

PE sessions will be on a Wednesday afternoon. Mostly, we will be going outside to have our lessons.

## PSHE

Create class rules and practise routines. Achieving our class mission. Introducing yourself to someone new and being a good friend.

## RE

Learn about the Church family. We will be talking about who belongs to our family, then learn about some of the family connections in the Bible.
