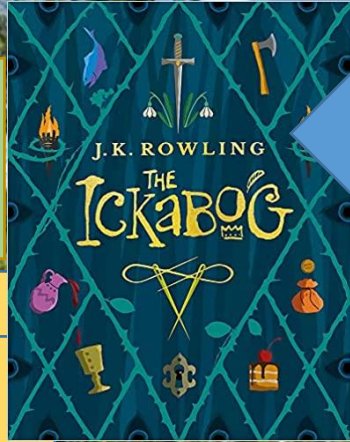


PE day is **Friday** so remember your kit!

We will be focussing on:

- Revision of word classes
- Formal and informal language
- A variety of sentence openers.
- Different sentence structures (including relative clauses) and simple sentences to build tension.
- Spelling, punctuation and grammar.
- Character, setting description and dialogue.
