

Independence

Please encourage your child to learn new self help skills. Teach them how to put on and take off their cardigans and jumpers. They should be able to make sure the sleeves are the right way out.

Talking

Try to have a gadget/TV free time every day and spend it playing and talking with your child. Introduce your child to new words. For example if you are building with lego you might use construct, demolish, design, spacious, extravagant to describe what you are making.

Seesaw

Please check seesaw regularly and show your children the posts that feature them. Ask them to tell you what they were doing.
