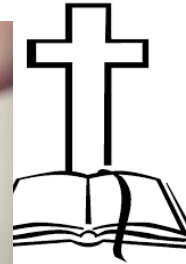

Locate 2 digit numbers using number line and a hundred square.

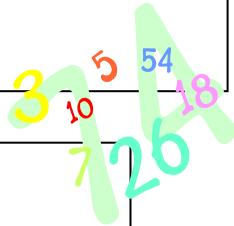
Read and write numbers to 100 in numerals and words.
