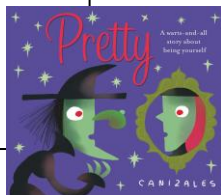

Count in steps of 2, 3 and 5 from 0

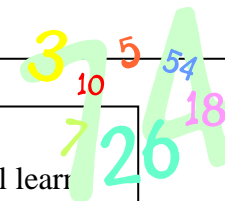
Begin to learn column addition.

Interpret and construct pictograms, tally charts, block diagrams and simple tables

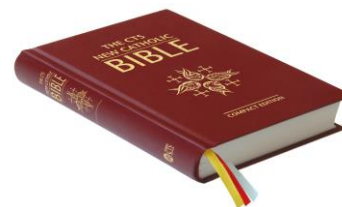
