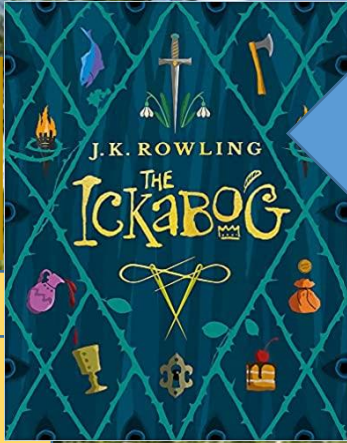


PE day is **Friday** so remember your kit!
