

R.E and Collective Worship

In our 'Family' topic, we will talk about our families and the love we have for each other and the love God has for us. In our 'Belonging' topic we will learn that Baptism is an invitation to belong to God's family.

Maths - We will sort objects into order; compare and order numbers to 10 on a number line and learn our number bonds. We will use our knowledge to answer reasoning questions and do some problem solving.

D.T / Art

Art – Kandinsky - we will be exploring Kandinsky's art work and creating our own versions using a variety of methods such as chalk and paint.

D.T – Food - we will be learning about food hygiene and developing chopping skills to create our own fruit kebabs.

Music: - We will begin to use different vocal sounds, perform simple, copycat rhythms and use our thinking voice.

Science - We will begin our year-long learning about seasonal changes. We will sort animals into insects, fish, amphibians, reptiles, birds and mammals using Venn diagrams and sorting trees and talk about differences between humans and animals.

Geography: Local Geography Week

– We will have the opportunity to learn all about our local area whilst developing a variety of field work skills.

PSHE – We will learn our 3, important class rules, learn strategies to resolve simple conflicts and mend friendships and recognise how others might be feeling by reading body language and facial expressions.

P.E. - We will build-up skills of catching, throwing and turn-taking.

English:

Fiction – We will be listening to, talking about and acting out 'Bear Hunt' by Michael Rosen. We will learn to retell the story off by heart and write some short sentences about the story. After half term we will explore the text A Dark Tale and write our own spooky stories.

Non-Fiction – We will be reading information books about bears and writing our own information texts.

Poetry – we will listen to a poem every day at home time and our focus poem will be Ten Things Found in a Wizard's Pocket. We will explore this poem after half term.

Phonics - We will starting our new unit 'Choose to Use' where we will be learning some new sounds to help us with our reading and writing. We will also be learning to read and write some more common exception words.

Computing:

Digital Citizenship: We will learn to recognise warning signs while online and know how to get help. We will access the internet in an age-appropriate way and know what information should be kept private. We will learn how to behave appropriately online and be aware of the rules for keeping safe online.

Digital Literacy – We will learn how to log on, learn some basic typing skills on a keyboard and explore the creation of a simple music track.
